### "Transforming Challenges into Solutions" – International congress on headache and facial pain

From 3 - 6 December, experts from all over the world will meet at the CCL, Lisbon Congress Centre, to present new scientific findings on the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of headaches and migraines, addressing key issues in headache medicine and shaping the future of the field. The congress participants can look forward to high-level plenaries, cutting-edge debate sessions, interactive teaching courses, forward-looking updates, and interesting poster presentations.

As the co-chairs affirm, the congress is not just about learning — it's about engaging, exchanging, and inspiring. From cutting-edge discoveries to practical strategies that improve patient care, expect dynamic and interactive sessions designed to enhance participation, stimulate debate, and leave the participants empowered as part of a strong European team driving headache science forward. They will have the chance to network, brainstorm, and connect with peers, opinion leaders, and innovators.
